Corona Protocol

Pineville Neighbors Place remains open during this challenging time. We have put some changes in place, so please read carefully.

Financial Assistance: Crisis Assistance is closed for now, but we continue to work with Good Friends and Good Fellows to help with rent and utilities. Even though utility companies have pledged not to disconnect, and eviction hearings are not occurring, it is still imperative that our clients stay current on their bills. The applications will be completed over email and the phone.

Furniture: Beds for Kids is closed for now, so we are not processing furniture requests.

Food: To limit the exposure of our clients and volunteers, we have transitioned to a drive-up pantry. Clients may call the office when they arrive, and a volunteer will deliver a box of groceries to their car. If someone needs food and does not have transportation, it will be delivered to their home.

Lunches for Children


