Loaves and Fishes is hosting a mobile food pantry each Thursday 10-11:30 am at Harrison United Methodist Church, 15008 Lancaster Highway. It is a drive-thru pantry where they put the food in your car. This is an excellent opportunity to get some fresh, nutritious food for your family. Call the PNP office today to get a referral for this weekly event. You may go up to 12 times in a 365-day period.

Corona Protocol

Pineville Neighbors Place remains open during this challenging time. We have put some changes in place, so please read carefully.

Financial Assistance: Crisis Assistance has reopened, and we continue to work with Good Friends and Good Fellows to help with rent and utilities. The governor has placed a moratorium on evictions through June 19 and on disconnections of utilities through July 29. **NOW** is the time to get current with your bills. Funding is available. The applications will be completed over email and the phone.

Furniture: Beds for Kids is making deliveries, so we are processing furniture requests.

Food: To limit the exposure of our clients and volunteers, we have transitioned to a drive-up pantry. Clients may call the office when they arrive, and a volunteer will deliver a box of groceries to their cars. If someone needs food and does not have transportation, we will deliver it to their home.

Food donations may be dropped off on the office porch anytime. We post the pantry needs each week on social media (Facebook, Twitter and Instagram).

Medicines: Thanks to our partnership with MedAssist, we have over the counter medicines for distribution. There are no qualifications to receive the medicine. They are for anyone. We have cold and allergy meds for children and adults, eye drops, cotton balls, heartburn meds and a variety of vitamins.
